Hunar Foundation's key objective is to provide school graduates and other young adults with international standard vocational training that meets the expectations of the market, leading to employment or small business creation – and eventually economic freedom and empowerment. Hunar Foundation offers this opportunity to the underprivileged and marginalized segments of society where the need is more urgent.

Today Hunar Foundation has five institutes (four for men and one for women), to be increased to

7 BY THE END OF 2016 and to

30 BY 2020

Half of these institutes will be devoted to teaching trades to women. By 2025, the goal is to train and certify 300,000 young men and women into bread earners for their families. **THAT MEANS OVER 2 MILLION OF THEIR DEPENDENTS WILL BE LIFTED OUT OF POVERTY AND WILL BE SUPPORTED BY HUNAR GRADUATES FOR THEIR HEALTH AND EDUCATION NEEDS.** The real aim is to act as a catalyst to promote vocational training in Pakistan, raise the bar of technical training in Pakistan with international qualifications, and make our graduates employable in Pakistan and abroad.

We continuously enhance technical skills of our instructors by sending selected instructors to Australia, Germany and the US, besides inviting instructors and advisors from Germany and Australia for month-long sessions in Pakistan.

CURRENT & UPCOMING INSTITUTES

HUNAR FOUNDATION KHARIAN CAMPUS

This is located in Karambagh in Kharian, Gujrat district. The institute is designed to accommodate 1000 students eventually.

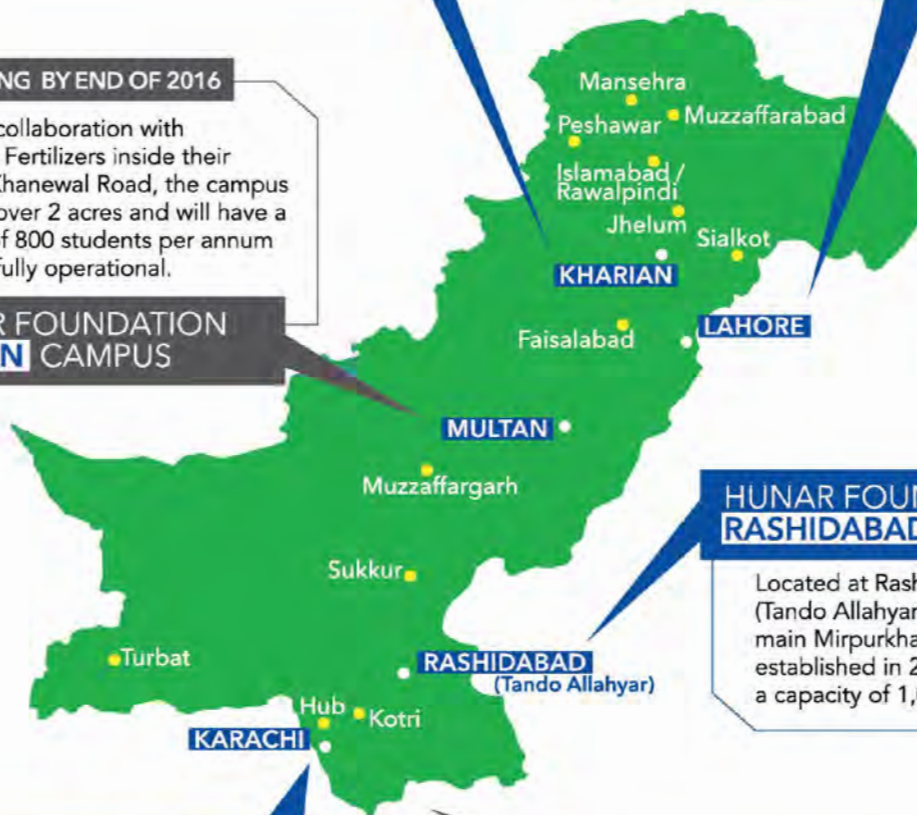
This campus started functioning in 2014. The institute has a total capacity of 1,500 students.

HUNAR FOUNDATION LAHORE CAMPUS (BEDIAN)

UPCOMING BY END OF 2016

Set up in collaboration with PAKARAB Fertilizers inside their plant on Khanewal Road, the campus is spread over 2 acres and will have a capacity of 800 students per annum once it is fully operational.

HUNAR FOUNDATION MULTAN CAMPUS



HUNAR FOUNDATION RASHIDABAD CAMPUS

Located at Rashidabad, (Tando Allahyar district), on main Mirpurkhas Road, it was established in 2012, and has a capacity of 1,000 students.

HUNAR FOUNDATION KARACHI CAMPUS (DMS School)

Located adjacent to Tariq Road, the heart of the city, and inside the premises of Delhi Mercantile Society, School it was the first institute of Hunar Foundation and can accommodate 440 students.

HUNAR FOUNDATION KARACHI CAMPUS (KORANGI)

Spread over 2.5 acres, this campus will include institutes for both males and females, as well as a teacher training center. Once both are completed, they will be able to house 2000 students.

UPCOMING BY END OF 2016

HUNAR FOUNDATION WOMEN'S INSTITUTE KARACHI

This is the first women institute established by Hunar in 2015. It is in process of relocation but will continue to be located in Karachi.

WORKING CLOSELY WITH INDUSTRY

Placement Department at Corporate Headquarters oversees the working of every institution's Placement Office, their frequency of visits, job posting and follow up of queries.

The department lists the opportunities with requirements from specific organizations, and arrange for Exhibitions/Job Fairs at each institute.

An Industrial Linkages Office is also being established at Hunar to prepare industry related skill sets and curriculum, to initiate internship programmes, and to extract the real need of each organization at the right time before graduation of particular batch of students. The Industrial Linkages Office will also develop close relationship with employer federations, trade associations and chamber of commerce in major industrial cities.



COOPERATIVE VOCATIONAL TRAINING

The Cooperative Vocational Training (CVT) scheme addresses the need for demand oriented training by combining vocational courses in training institutions with On-The-Job training in enterprises; one year at Hunar and one year in partner industry.

The CVT is supported by the TVET Reform Support Programme, which is funded by the European Union, the Embassy of the Kingdom of the Netherlands, the Federal Republic of Germany and the Royal Norwegian Embassy, and has been commissioned by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development.

GiZ is implementing this programme in close collaboration with the National Vocational & Technical Training Commission (NAVTTTC).

TRADES CURRENT AND FUTURE

We select our trades on the following criteria:

1. They are demand driven. Hunar researches industry needs for the short and long term future. Then it develops and teaches courses designed to meet these requirements.
2. The trades lead to self-employment and entrepreneurship, especially among women so they could run their businesses from home easily.

THESE COURSES ARE CERTIFIED BY THE TRADE TESTING BOARD (SINDH, PAKISTAN) AS WELL AS BY CITY & GUILDS (UK) WHOSE CERTIFICATION IS RECOGNISED PRIMARILY IN EUROPE, MIDDLE EAST, AFRICA, ASIA, AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND.
