AMTI Taiser Town Campus Opens to Empower Generations!

The Hunar Foundation proudly launched its newest campus, the Ajmal Mian Technical Institute (AMTI), in the heart of Taiser Town, Karachi – an area where thousands of young people leave school with no clear path to work. AMTI is designed to change that.

Its first cohort of 117 students enrolled in market-relevant trades including General Electrician, Motorcycle Mechanic, Computer Operator, Digital Marketing & SEO, and a Customized Cutting & Stitching. Building on this momentum, the second cohort will begin in July 2025 with an expanded course offering. Two new digital trades—Office Assistant and Computer Graphics—will be introduced, increasing the institute's annual training capacity to 400 students across all programs. These aren't just courses — they're pipelines into real employment.

For many families in the area, this will be the first

time a household member is trained for skilled work — a shift that can change not just income, but mindset, confidence, and opportunity across generations.

"We are creating pathways for economic empowerment, especially for youth who've been overlooked for far too long", said a THF representative.



One Mission, One Team: THF Leadership Aligns for Greater Impact!

The Hunar Foundation hosted a dynamic 3 - day Leadership Conference led by our CEO – Sustainability, Ghufran Khan, bringing together Institute Managers, team leads and department heads for an immersive experience of reflection, collaboration, and growth. The sessions encouraged participants to unlearn limiting





patterns, embrace cross-functional learning, and openly identify internal gaps — with the goal of driving meaningful, organization-wide improvements. More than a planning exercise, the conference helped realign leadership around a shared purpose and prepared teams to move forward with greater clarity and agility.



The Hunar Foundation Advances Minority Inclusion!

The Hunar Foundation hosted the Hindu Foundation for a focused discussion on expanding vocational training access for Hindu youth in underserved regions such as Umerkot, Tharparkar, and Mirpurkhas. The conversation explored the design of market-relevant courses in digital skills, tailoring,





electrical work, and hospitality. Both organizations emphasized that inclusive, skills-based education is key to reducing inequality and unlocking economic potential in marginalized areas.

Powered by Industry: THF and Lucky One Mall Commit to Aligning Training with Real-World Needs!

Following an initial meeting at The Hunar Foundation's Head Office, THF deepened its engagement with Lucky One Mall through a strategic follow-up visit to their premises. The focus of this visit was to explore designing a tailored technical training program of Vertical Transportation Systems (VTS) — with emphasis on Mechanical, Electrical, and Mechatronics disciplines.

Lucky One Mall management expressed a strong willingness to co-develop the curriculum in partnership with THF to ensure it aligns with real-world industry requirements. In addition, they highlighted an ongoing





need for trained professionals in MEP trades across their extensive facility.

As part of the visit, THF was given a guided tour of critical infrastructure, including Electrical systems, HVAC, VTS, Plumbing, and other back-end operations, offering valuable insight into the technical skills required to maintain such complex commercial operations.

Recognizing the potential impact of this partnership, THF invited the group to consider establishing a state-of-the-art technical institute in Karachi as part of their CSR commitment—a facility that could serve as a long-term hub for developing job-ready, skilled youth.
