Hunar Healthcare organized a Mega Health Camp at the Feroz Fatima Healthcare & Technical Institute (FFHTI), reaffirming its commitment to holistic development, community well-being, and improving access to quality healthcare services.

The camp provided free medical consultations, screenings, and preventive healthcare services to students, staff, and members of the surrounding community. A wide range of services were offered, including diabetes screening, general physician consultations, gynecology, eye examinations, physiotherapy, dental care, and



psychological counseling. Participants also received discount vouchers for follow-up laboratory tests and specialist consultations at Jamila Sultan Hospital.

The 2nd Graduation Ceremony at Ajmal Mian Technical Institute (AMTI) celebrated the achievements of more than 150 graduates across five market-relevant trades. A significant number of graduates are already economically engaged, while others have chosen to pursue higher education - reflecting the trans-

formative power of skills-based learning in expanding career prospects and enabling dignified livelihoods.

The ceremony marked another important milestone in THF's mission to Build a Skilled Pakistan, demonstrating how industry-relevant training, coupled with strong employability outcomes, can empower young men and women to become productive contributors to their families, communities, and the economy.

Demonstrating the spirit of innovation and practical problem-solving, a Solar Simulator was successfully designed and developed in-house at THF – AMTI by Electrical Instructor Mr. Ayaz in collaboration with trainees. The initiative significantly reduced costs compared to external procurement while creating a valuable learning opportunity for students. The simulator will be integrated into regular electrical training programs as well as the Fundamentals of Solar Systems short course, enhancing hands-on learning and strengthening THF's capacity to deliver industry-relevant training in renewable energy technologies. The project reflects THF's commitment to fostering innovation, technical excellence, and experiential learning among both instructors and trainees.
