Groundbreaking of New Campus at Orangi Town

The Hunar Foundation (THF) marked the ground-breaking of a new campus at Salim Zubairi & Abdul Khaliq Allahwala Training Institute (SAZAKTI), Orangi Town, generously supported by Liberty Textiles (Mukaty Family). The purpose-built facility, spanning 14,500 sq. ft., will accommodate 200 students per shift, offering Electrical, Digital, Mechanical, and Plumbing trades, supported by fully equipped labs. Construction is expected to be completed within eight months.



Designed with future scalability in mind, the structure can support up to four additional floors, enabling a significant increase in training capacity. With continued donor support, the campus has the potential to create hundreds of additional seats, expanding access to skills based training and enabling thousands of youth in one of Karachi's most underserved communities to move towards dignified livelihoods.

Recruitment Drives Strengthen Industry Linkages

THF facilitated multiple industry-led recruitment engagements during February with Lucky Motor Corporation, Revoo E-Bikes, and Al Karam Textile, creating direct pathways from training to employment for THF graduates.

Over 100 alumni were interviewed across technical trades at Hunar Karigar Campus, while 21 candidates



engaged with Revoo E-Bikes at Tariq Road campus. In addition, 20 female Stitching graduates were shortlisted by Al Karam for onboarding.

These engagements reflect the growing demand for THF-trained professionals and reinforce how skills based training, supported by donors and industry, translates into meaningful career opportunities and sustainable livelihoods.

Empowering 500 Graduates at Orangi Town Campus



A significant milestone was achieved at THF's Orangi Town Campus (SAZAKTI), where 500 students successfully completed their training across a range of trades, including Digital Marketing, Graphic Designing, Fashion Designing, Hair & Beauty Services (Level 3), MS Office, Beautician, Cutting & Stitching, and English Language.



Representing two graduating cohorts, these students now step forward equipped with market relevant skills, practical exposure, and renewed confidence.

The ceremony reflected not only student achievement but also the commitment of faculty whose mentorship played a key role in this journey. This milestone reinforces THF's mission to create structured pathways to employability and sustainable livelihoods.

Empower Her Bazar: Enabling Women-Led Enterprises

THF supported startups participated in the Empower Her Bazar at Jaffer Group, where seven women led ventures showcased their products and services. The platform provided valuable market exposure and enabled engagement with potential investors, including participation in the Shark Den Investor Pitch Deck.
