Welcoming 5,000+ Students Across The Hunar Foundation (THF) Campuses

THF began the new training cycle with strong momentum, welcoming more than 5,000 young men and women across its institutes nationwide. The World Bank Delegation Visits THF

During the visit, the delegation toured Saeeda Naseem Technical Institute (SNTI) and RAAS Institute of Emerging Technologies (RIET) to experience THF's model of industry-aligned, skills-based training aimed at empowering Pakistan's
